## FOOTBALL TEAM/ FOOTBALL CLUB

Good luck to the football team who are in action at Timperley Sports Club, meaning that the football club will take place at Bowdon Sports Club this week and for the rest of this half term except for Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> October when we are back at Timperley.

A couple of reminders:

- 1. All children should wear shin pads
- 2. Parents will collect children in the Bowdon car park from Bowdon C of E. Please do not drop your child in the car park and allow them to walk unattended to the astroturf. Please park and walk your child to the astroturf and, at the end, please walk and collect them from staff.
- 3. Football has been moved from Monday to Tuesday for this academic year. The change was due to staffing and pitch availability. Unfortunately, we could not confirm this change earlier as Timperley did not confirm pitch availability until the end of the summer holidays.
- 4. A parent has contacted us to ask for a coach to be put on to transport children from school to Timperley/Bowdon. The coach would cost approximately £400 to go from Hale Prep to Timperley/Bowdon. If all parents agreed, the cost would be approximately £10 per child

per trip. We will conduct a survey to see who would be interested in the hiring of a coach and will let you know the results. We will do what we can to help.
