Treasurers Report – Sarah Malkin	INFO
The accounts which were presented at the meeting on 20 <sup>th</sup> June 2024 had net incomings of £8,583, and this has since increased for the year ended 31 August 2024 to £9,597. The increase is due to a successful second-hand uniform sale at the end of the year which raised an additional £462 and a net profit of £553 raised at the infant disco.	
During the current financial year, the PTA has received a grant of £1,000 from a charitable trust towards the library refurbishment. The school have asked the PTA if it can contribute a total of £10,000 towards the library in total. It has currently committed £7,500 towards the project and has received a grant of £1,000. This would be an additional £1,500 of PTA funds. Unfortunately, there were not sufficient committee members present at the meeting to pass a vote, and it was agreed that this vote would happen separately.	
The bank balance at the end of the financial year was £15,141. It was discussed that the PTA has very kindly been given a donation of £4,471.85 which has been given to go towards children's physical development. Ideas for the use of this donation are currently being explored, and the donation is eligible for gift aid by the PTA.
